

CURRENT PROJECTS





Construction of the second runway at the Minsk National Airport: ~USD 255 mn

Financing of the construction of facilities for the Second European Games in Belarus in 2019: ~EUR 85.1 mn





Reconstruction of an electric power substation in the Minsk region: EUR 30.9 mn





COMPLETED PROJECTS





First stage construction of the third line of the Minsk subway (total length 17.2 km): ~USD 100 mn. **Mission**: improvement of ecological situation and development of public transport in Minsk

Purchase of three Embraer aircrafts for Belavia for USD 72.1 mn in cooperation with BNDES (Brazil)





Purchase of a mechanized tunnel boring machine for construction of the Minsk subway: EUR 9.6 mn





COMPLETED PROJECTS





Construction of a stadium in Borisov (the only FIFA authorised football stadium in Belarus): ~USD 8.5 mn

Construction of the second ring road around Minsk (total length >160 km and capacity of ~20,000 vehicles per day): ~ USD 190 mn. **Mission**: improvement of ecological situation in Minsk


